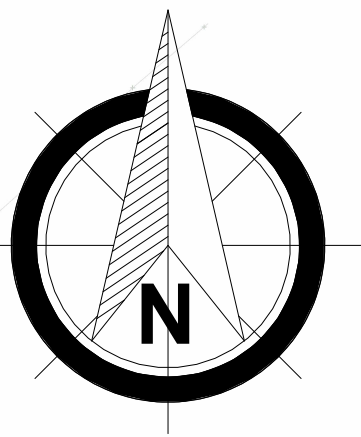




SITE PLAN - 1:500

Griselinia Littoralis planted to entrance wing and wrapped along site road to aid screening

Min. 20 metre bound surface

Tarmacadam entrance to blend into existing nearside cammageway. Entrance levels currently slope towards nearside road edge.
Site entrance levels will be reduced from nearside road edge and surface water run-off to be intercepted with road gullies and managed on site.

Existing group of leylandii trees removed

Griselinia Littoralis planted to entrance wing and wrapped along site road to aid screening
